- Entries must arrive by 14 August 2022. Entries received after this date will not be included in the competition. The promoter will not be responsible for any entries that are not received for any reason, by the closing date, whether lost, delayed, corrupted or otherwise, and whether or not due to any technical difficulties or malfunctions.
- Entries cannot be returned to entrants.
- All entries must be accompanied by a valid entry form (above).
- The art must be an original and not a copy of previous designs.
- Children's competition applications must have given the age of the child at the time and consent from a parent or carer.
- The National Autistic Society reserves the right to disqualify any entrant if we have reasonable grounds to believe the entrant has breached any of the rules.
- The winning artwork will be printed in *Your Autism* (children's competition) and *the Spectrum* (adults' competition) and available in the online versions.
- No cash alternative will be offered.
- The decision of the judges is final - no correspondence will be entered into.
- Winners will be notified in September 2022 via email unless your contact preference is otherwise.
- The National Autistic Society reserves the right to display or promote entries when it feels it will help promote the charitable aims of the National Autistic Society.
- The copyright of the art will remain with you. However, as a condition of entry you agree to grant the National Autistic Society a worldwide exclusive licence to reproduce the art in its magazines and any other print, online or electronic publication, including social media.
